Scouts attending need to be in complete uniform (as in Class "A" / Field Uniform). Bring a Blue-Card, filled out with **YOUR** information and signed by your Scoutmaster. This is perfect if you plan backcountry hikes, or a trip to Philmont. Stay in contact!

PARENTS! You can participate in the class as well, and take the exam; if you pass the exam, you and your child will have a new, exciting, and fun hobby for your entire family.

You will need to purchase and read the course book, it can be purchased from the ARRL, or from Amazon— Just do a search.

PRE-REGISTRATION is required for the class, and the test. Go to W4CEC.com and register. You will find the directions to get an FRN (FCC Registration Number) if you do not have one. You can also register for just the test if you are planning to upgrade your license. NO WALK-Ins will be accepted without prior communication.
